- Develop resources for teachers, students, and community members to engage in environmental learning



Hosting Events & Convening Community

- Coordinate the largest Earth Day Fair in NC, with education and action opportunities for 8,000+ people
- Build diverse community networks and partnerships through a Sustainability Roundtable twice annually
- Present a Green Home Tour to inspire sustainable practices
- Convene a monthly Environmental Action Coalition to advocate for and implement local environmental policy
